

Alliance of Portage County Snowmobile and ATV/UTV Clubs Countywide Poker Run

Details and Rules

WHAT: The Alliance of Portage County Snowmobile and ATV/UTV Clubs is sponsoring a Poker Run to raise funds to help our clubs when they need it. Poker runs are like any good event giving like-minded individuals a great opportunity to get together and have some fun. Complete the ride on whatever vehicle you like.

WHEN: Now through September 22, 2024

WHERE: The Sponsors listed in the book. We will have an ending party on September 22.

WHO: Alliance of Portage County Snowmobile and ATV/UTV Clubs

REGISTRATION: Purchase a book for \$10.

PROCESS: Stop at the sponsors listed in the book and have them punch a hole in your book letting us know that you attended their establishment. Come to the year-end party on September 22, 2024, at Backwoods Bar and Grill from 12 pm – 4 pm. Submit your books by 2 pm to have your cards drawn. Additional hands can be purchased for \$10 each.

WINNING HAND: The winner of the event is the participant who makes the best five-card poker hand at the end of the event determined by standard five card poker hand rankings. If there is a tie, the participants included in the tie will each draw a card from a complete deck and the participant with the highest card will win. The ranking order is spades, hearts, clubs then diamonds. There will be no “wild cards” allowed and each participant will only be allowed one “hand” recorded on an official score sheet. 30% of the money collected will be awarded to the 1st place winner, 20% of the money collected will be awarded to the 2nd place winner, and 10% of the money will be awarded to the 3rd place winner.

Poker Hand Rankings (highest to lowest):

- Royal Flush: Run of sequential cards from Ten to Ace, with all cards of the same suit.
- Straight Flush: Run of sequential cards, all cards in the same unit, but not Ace high.
- Four of a Kind: Four cards of the same rank; e.g. four Aces, Four Kings, etc.
- Full House: Three cards of the same rank plus a pair, e.g. three Aces and a pair of Kings.
- Flush: Five cards all of the same suit.
- Straight (Run): Five sequential cards, not of the same suit.
- Three of a Kind: Three cards of the same rank e.g. three Aces, three Kings etc.
- Two Pair: Two sets of pairs e.g. a pair of Aces and a pair of Kings.
- Pair: Two cards of the same rank e.g. two Aces, two Kings etc.
- High Card: If you have none of the above, then the highest value card in your hand plays.

Presentation of Awards: The presentation of awards will be at 3 p.m.

ATV/UTV Reminders: The speed limit is 35 mph unless otherwise posted. This is per state statute. Ride single file. Check out local ordinances for riding times.
